## Discussed rates for students AY19

- Student Health Fee
  - A 3% increase for AY19 was submitted to the University as part of the annual Budget Letter distribution by the Office of Financial Strategy and Planning.
- Student Health Insurance Plan
  - Proposed an increase of 7.5% for AY19, a 1.5% decrease from the initial guidance of 9%
